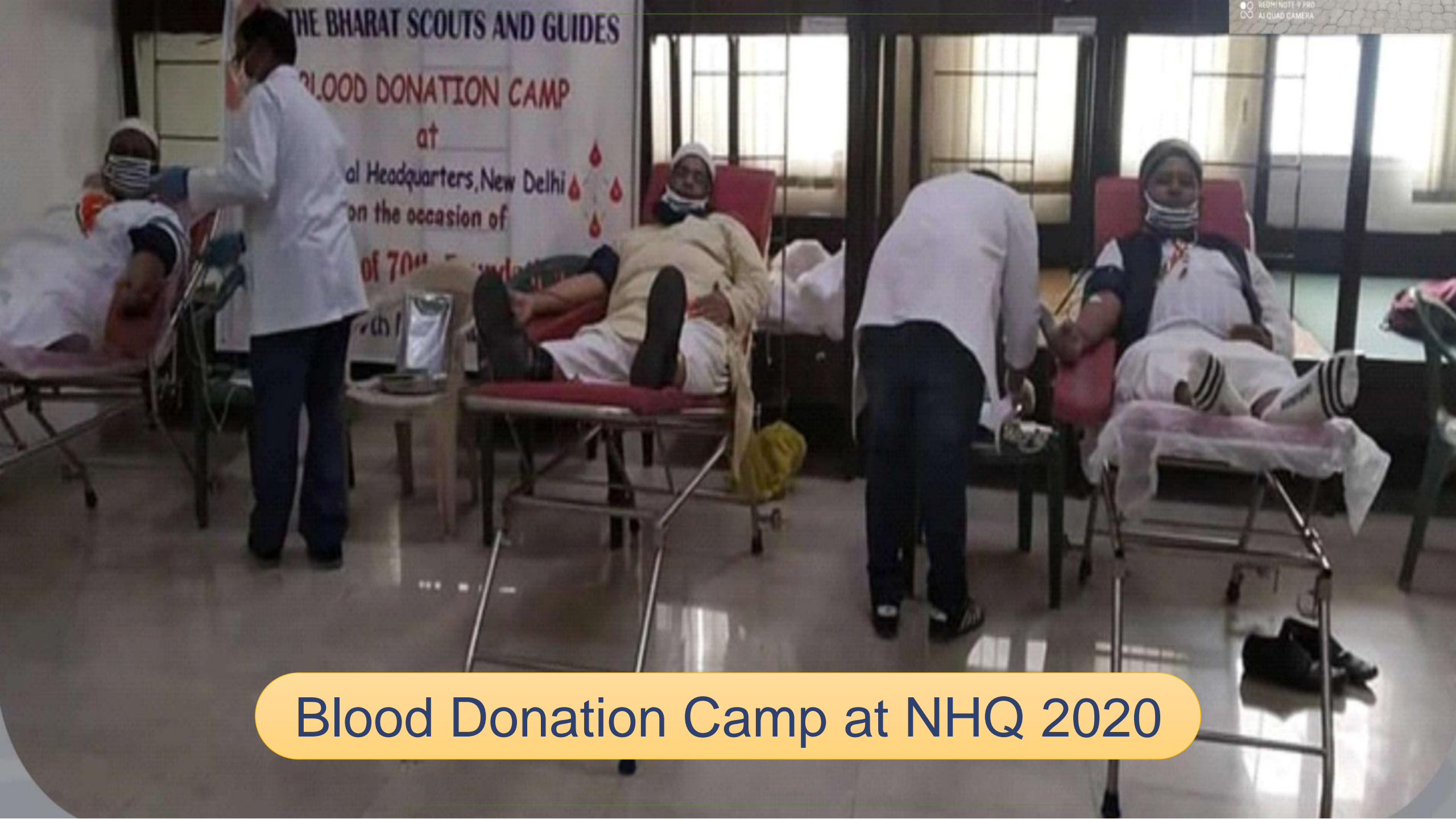
# Ambulance, Oxygen & Funeral During Covid 19
