SN	Case	Current Status
1	Hate Speech & Blasphemy Petition	Settled on 29 April 2026. Court stated existing laws are sufficient.
2	Jahangirpuri Bulldozer Action filed in 2022	SC restricted bulldozer justice in Nov 2024; case still pending.
3	Dalit Muslim SC Status filed in 2023	No hearing since 2023.
4	Love Jihad Case	No hearing since April 2025.
5	Gujarat Love Jihad Act	Fresh notices issued to Centre and 12 states in Feb 2026.
6	Halal Trust Case	Several hearings completed; no hearing after Feb 2025.
7	NCPCR Madrasa Case	Court stayed transfer of madrasa children to schools.

SN	Case	Current Status
1	Haldwani Bulldozer Action	In February 2026, the Supreme Court refused to recognize any legal rights of the families occupying railway land in Banbhoolpura, Haldwani, holding that the land belongs to the Indian Railways and that the occupants cannot dictate the terms of rehabilitation. However, considering the humanitarian aspect of the matter, the Court directed that assistance for rehabilitation be provided under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY).
2	Waqf Act 2025 Challenge	In September 2025, some interim relief was granted through a temporary order; however, the Court's failure to stay the "Waqf by User" provision remains a matter of serious concern.
3	Shariat Application Act Protection	In December 2024, the Supreme Court imposed an interim stay on the filing of any new cases against mosque

Assam NRC Related Cases – I

SN	Case	Current Status
1.	Citizenship Amendment Act	Pending since 2021; hearing scheduled for 5 May 2026.
2.	Assam Tribunal Amendment Order	This case was filed in the Supreme Court in 2019. In November 2025, the Supreme Court issued fresh notices to the Central Government and the Government of Assam on a joint petition filed by the All Minority Students Union and Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind. Jamiat has demanded that rejection slips be issued to approximately 1.9 million individuals excluded from the NRC, as the appellate process under Section 3A cannot commence without them.
3.	Aadhaar Acceptance in NRC case in Supreme court	The Supreme Court is hearing petitions concerning the use of Aadhaar cards for individuals included in the supplementary list of Assam's NRC. The petitions argue that withholding biometric information constitutes an arbitrary and unreasonable exercise of power. Government Development: In August 2024, the Government of Assam announced that the Central Government had agreed to unlock the biometrics of approximately 935,000 individuals.

At the time of filing, the Court granted interim protection by restraining the authorities from detaining or requiring the children of such declared foreigners to report before authorities.</p>
5.	<p>Fatima Begum & Others vs. Union of India, Secretary Home Affairs & Others</p> <p>Subject: A case concerning proceedings before the Foreigners Tribunal (FT) relating to the children of persons declared as foreigners.</p>	<p>An appeal was filed before the Supreme Court against the judgment of the Gauhati High Court, where the Supreme Court stayed the declaration of these individuals as foreigners. However, the case has remained pending since 2020.</p>
6.	<p>Abdul Qasim Talha vs. Union of India & Others</p> <p>Subject: A case concerning proceedings before the Foreigners Tribunal (FT) involving the entire family members of persons declared as foreigners.</p>	<p>Pending since 2020.</p>

7.	Amiruddin Mujumdar vs. Union of India & Others Subject: A case concerning the declaration of D-Voters as Indian citizens by the Foreigners Tribunal (FT) courts.	Pending since 2020 regarding D-Voters.
8.	Challenge to the Central Government's Notification on the Passport Amendment Rules and the Foreigners Amendment Order	Pending since 2020.
9.	Petition Filed by Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind Assam Before the Supreme Court Subject: A petition seeking to halt the bulldozer action in Goalpara district, Assam.	On 24 July 2025, the Supreme Court issued notice to the State Government, and the matter is presently pending before a three-judge bench.
